ETYMOLOGY

Northern Saw-whet Owl
(Aegolius acadicus)

The genus term "*Aegolius*" stems from a Greek root which means "bird of ill omen" referring to owls more generally, particularly their vocalizations. "*Acadicus*" is an adaptation of "Acadia," which localizes this bird just to our north. The common name of this bird, saw-whet, may refer to its vocalization. During breeding it can sound a bit like a saw being sharpened!
